ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only)	FROM £2000
This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation	
Taking care of all the necessary legal administrative arrangements including liaising with the appropriate authorities, making and receiving all necessary telephone calls, attendance of the Funeral Director along with sufficient bearers on the day of the funeral service.	£950.00
Viewing of the deceased by family and friends by appointment	£80.00
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death or Hospital (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's branch premises) and bringing them to our care until the funeral service.	£125.00
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate refrigerated facilities and full preparation prior to the funeral service. The deceased will be kept at my premise.	£170.00
Providing a coffin of choice e.g. oak veneer	From £400.00
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or cremation (normally within 20 miles of the funeral directors premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle	£275.00
UNATTENDED FUNERAL	
This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.	
Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£1450.00
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee) plus cremation fee ²	£1650.00
DISBURSMENT PAYMENTS	
For an Attended or Unattended burial funeral, the burial fee ¹	From £350
In this local area, the typical cost of the burial fee is: For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.	Dependant whether Council Cemetery in which borough or Churchyard
For an Attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee ²	From £761 - £1055 depending on Crematorium choice
